Dress Code

All volunteers, community service workers, and anyone else volunteering services at the Golden Spike Event Center must follow the described “General Rules” guidelines.

General Rules

- It is against policy to wear:
 - Baggy or “sagging” pants or shorts
 - Excessively oversized jackets or coats
 - Inappropriately short or revealing shorts, skirts, dresses, etc. The hem of the clothing article must be longer than the tips of your fingers when arms are held to the side of the leg.
 - Inappropriately tight shorts, skirts, pants, dresses, etc.
 - Clothing that is torn, ripped, or frayed
 - Clothing, or hats, which display obscene, vulgar, lewd, or sexually explicit words, messages, or pictures.
 - Clothing that expose bare midriffs, buttocks, or undergarments
 - Tank tops, halter tops, spaghetti straps, low-cut, or off the shoulder clothing, unless it is covered with a jacket, shirt, or sweater.
- Body Piercings – The only piercings that are allowed to display jewelry while on duty are ears, (3) rings/studs per ear. Facial piercings (including tongues) are not allowed. Jewelry displayed from other body piercings must be covered while on duty.
- Tattoos – Tattoos are acceptable as long as the tattoo is not obscene, vulgar, lewd, or depicts sexually explicit words, messages, or pictures. They must be covered if they are not acceptable by these standards.

Golden Spike Event Center staff reserves the right to determine what is appropriate. You may be asked to leave by GSEC staff if clothing, or appearance, is believed to be inappropriate.



Community Service Agreement

To be eligible to complete your community service hours at the Golden Spike Event Center (GSEC), you must **NOT** have a history of the following, and your sentence must **NOT** involve:

- A conviction of a violent or menacing nature
- A conviction of an offense of a sexual nature

Policies and Procedures that I will follow:

- All volunteers **MUST** sign in immediately before volunteering begins. A staff member **MUST** sign you out for your hours to be valid.
- All volunteers **MUST** wear an orange vest at all times.
- All volunteers **MUST** wear closed-toed shoes.
- Personal phone usage will **NOT** be allowed.
- No iPods or mp3 players.
- Wear appropriate clothing, abiding by GSEC dress code (see attached).
- Eating, or extended breaks, are permitted only after being checked out.
- Safety is first priority. Please be mindful of heavy machinery. Use proper lifting techniques. When lifting heavy objects, use your legs to push upwards, keep your back straight, and your body balanced.
- Report all accidents and injuries immediately to Facility Staff.
- Volunteers are responsible for cleaning up their area before checking out.
- GSEC will not be responsible for any missing personal belongings. Please leave anything of value in your car or at home.
- Sexual harassment, violence, or offensive speech will not be tolerated.
- No one under the influence of drugs and/or alcohol will be permitted to volunteer.
- Only staff members are allowed to operate heavy machinery.
- Bringing work gloves is recommended, but not required.

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Community Service Agreement

I also hereby release Weber County, its agents, and employees from any liability or obligation arising from, or in connection with, my community service activities with Weber County. In addition, I agree to indemnify and hold harmless Weber County, its agents, and employees from and against any and all liability, loss, expense (including reasonable attorney's fees), or claims for injury or damages arising out of my community services activities, but only in proportion to and to the extent such liability is caused by or a result of my negligent or intentional acts.
